Soon after discovering the pipe organ, he quickly found out about theatre organs by accidentally stumbling across a YouTube video and was instantly hooked. Since the Fall of 2022, Seamus has been a guest organist at Organ Stop Pizza in Mesa, Arizona, home to the largest theatre organ in the world, where he fills in as needed throughout the year.
